LEAP!

How is God asking you and your family to take a LEAP of faith in 2026?

*...grant to your servants to continue to speak
your word with all boldness. (Acts 4:29)*

As we walk through the book of Acts in Sunday morning worship, we will be asking the question of what the church looked like then and how we are being asked to do the same. The early church changed the world because it's people lived out of their faith rather than out of obligation to God. Life is more than a rat race for acceptance and success. We get to LEAP into new adventures together as families and as the church.

In 2026, the leadership and I have identified three areas we see God at work in us. First, we are a training ground for future church leaders. God does this with our youth and young adults who are getting their first taste of ministry. We are creating podcasts, teaching Sunday School, providing scholarships and we will advertise for a Seminary Intern in 2026. Part of this investment is remodeling a new youth room and renovating the Gathering House to be a Seminary Greenhouse. We plan to have 2-3 rooms where students can live as they get real experience leading in the church here at Messiah.

Other concrete ways our families might be asked to LEAP are in celebrating 125 years of ministry and getting more involved in our community with our benevolence and ministry partners.

Messiah Lutheran tithes our weekly offerings to local and international charities. What would it look like for your family to make a connection with one of those partners? What a LEAP of faith to spend even one day as a family volunteering at MorningStar Mission or Living Alternatives Pregnancy Resource Center. We have a dozen ministries who use our space throughout the week. What would it look like for your family to welcome and create connections for the families already coming through our doors for *Lil' Loves*, *Stay-N-Play*, *YMCA Kid Zone*, or an exciting new ministry that supports foster families: *Love Moves.US*? There are many more!

Finally, throughout the year 2026 we will be celebrating our 125th year of ministry. Part of that celebration will be laying the foundation for our new bell tower. Much like our *Baptism Sunday*, anniversary celebrations are an evangelism moment. Now is the time to invite others into this Holy Spirit movement. What a LEAP it truly is to start that conversation about Sunday morning worship and what it means to you. The next time someone comments on your faith, your positive attitude, your willingness to help... that is God giving you the nudge to LEAP! The same Holy Spirit is at work in the church today as when it first began.

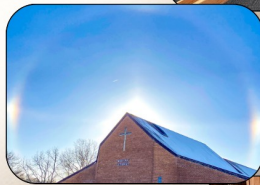

Our 125th Anniversary: 1901-2026!

As we celebrate our 125th anniversary as a church this year, this is how it all began:

Messiah Lutheran Church began taking shape in 1898 through the work of Norwegian immigrants as they settled in the Joliet area. Pastors O. Andreason, H.A. Hanson, Theo Hanson and a student pastor, Alte Svanoe, began preliminary work for the Norwegian Evangelical Lutheran Church on the corner of Hunter and McDonough in Joliet in the late 1890's. In the fall of 1901, at the home of Alfred Johnson on S. Water Street in Joliet, the first worship was organized. Pastor O.O. Risvold was instrumental in organizing the church and was the first pastor in 1901.

On Thanksgiving Day 1902, the congregation decided to purchase and build a church and parsonage at the corner of Hunter Ave. and McDonough St. The lot cost \$600.00. The initial structure was completed in 1903 and the parsonage in 1912. In 1904, a constitution was drafted and adopted. The first name of our church was

"HAUGE NORWEGIAN EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH"

The Norwegian Language was the language of use in the church. That included worship services, constitution and church records. It wasn't until 1919 that the annual meeting records were written in English and, in 1921, the constitution was translated into English. Transition to English was difficult and lengthy and as the years went by, pressure built within the church to start using the English language. The change was gradual and, in 1924, worship services were held once a month in English. The other services were still in Norwegian until 1937.

The final service was held at the Hunter Avenue Church, 320 Hunter Ave. on June 19, 1980. Church members caravanned to the new church site at 40 Houbolt Rd. for the conclusion of that worship service. From July 8, 1980 to Palm Sunday (April 12, 1981) worship services took place at Troy-Shorewood School. Palm Sunday was the first worship in the new facility. It was far from finished. Members brought chairs from home

for the church service. The floor was still concrete and other furnishings were sparse. But people rejoiced in His name because of what they had done together in the name of God!

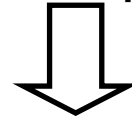

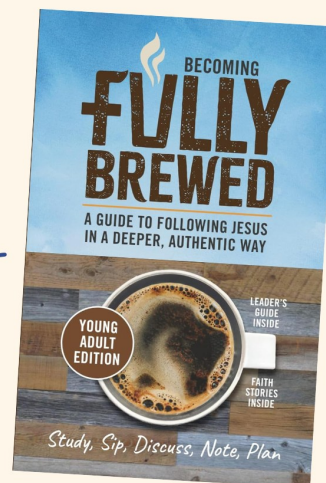
