FAITH & GIFT CARDS

I have asked for some wild things of church members before but I have never, nor will I ever, ask you for gift card serial numbers.

In lowa we had a laborer who had been working on the roof die of a heart attack. At one point, four of us staff members climbed the ladder onto the roof. We brought the AED (<u>Automated External Defibrillator</u>) and watched helplessly as the shocks did nothing.

Later, I was caring for this man's widow who had driven from two towns over to the hospital. I asked if there was anything we could do. One of her concerns was that she had not taken any time to stop for gas and her tank was way past "E."

At that time I called a church member directly and asked them to bring a can of gas to the hospital and put it in the orange Camaro parked across from the front door. When my faithful parishioner arrived, I was busy talking to another family member in front of the hospital and all I could do was give my guy a thumbs up as he took the liberty to crawl into this lady's car to pop the gas lid.

It was a bonding experience as we both took risks to help someone in need. I believe this is the same reason churches are targeted for gift card fraud. It is an honor to be asked a favor directly by your pastor. It is fulfilling when the act of service is something you can do. The email requests slowly invest you into the process, one step at a time, until you make the big sacrifice with the promise of repayment.

If you were duped by the bandits in our recent targeting, do not feel bad. They know what they are doing and have honed their skills for many years. They are the enemies that Jesus has commanded us to love.

And here is the irony: This attack unintentionally reconnected us with some of our members who had lost their church connection or ability to worship. What others meant for evil, God was still able to use for good.


BIBLE STUDY - New session 09/10!


Dear friends,



We will have some guilts for sale in the Narthex after each service and a door offering to help defray the cost of the batting and shipping of the guilts. You can even pick your favorite guilt off the pews to purchase that day!



This year, Lutheran World Relief celebrates their 80th anniversary. WORLD RELIEF While the world has changed and evolved, their core mission remained the same through all those

years. LWR dutifully loves their neighbors, wherever they are, and stays with them for as long as needed. This was the driving force that started LWR in 1945, when neighbors across the globe needed love and support after WWII. Lutherans banded together and were some of the first to arrive and last to leave—walking alongside their neighbors until they walked on their own. Thank you for your support and commitment to this loving legacy of helping God's children in need—no matter how far or how long it takes.

LWR efforts this year included sending quilts and kits to Mali and Lebanon, for the children and families fleeing their homes from violence and rebuilding at displacement camps. Quilts were also sent for those affected by wildfires and floods here in the United States.

Our quilting ministry here at Messiah began over 30 years ago. Through the years we have met monthly and made over 2,700 quilts that have been sent to LWR and around the world. Our group of 10-15 volunteers faithfully attend on the third Tuesday of each month to prepare the fabric, sew the tops together, sandwich the top, batting and bottom together, tie and sew the bindings to complete each quilt.

We also assemble sewing kits for LWR consisting of three yards of fabric, needles, buttons and thread. They are used in vocational training programs to teach young woman and men sewing skills that they can use to earn an income.
