LEAP

The word "leap" occurs 21 times in the ESV translation of the Bible. It is an Advent theme. John the Baptist as a fetus leaps in the womb of Elizabeth when he hears the voice of Mary the mother of God. All the wonder and hope needed in the truest test of faith for this young woman.

The first occurrences of "leap" is the description of David's uncontrollable <u>leaping</u> and dancing for joy on the return of the Arc to Jerusalem. A fascinating story in 2 Samuel 6. There are two references to Isreal's troops aided by God to <u>leap</u> over walls. In the Kingdom of God lame men <u>leap</u> (Acts 3:8) as prophesied in Isaiah 35. Terrified hearts heart's <u>leap</u> out of place (Job 37:1). God promises that when He gives us words that create faith and trust we will <u>leap</u> like calves from the stall (Malachi 4:2).

When is the last time you, your heart or your family leapt? When is the last time you were captured with the joy and freedom of being able to leap? Like a young child who can not help but run and leap simply for the fun of it. Just watch the kids holding a parent's hand in the shopping mall this season.

A leap is a gift from God produced by faith. It is a wild and playful disruption to our regular programming. It is daring to do something new not knowing where you might land. Leaping is what the church and its families do. God sets us free like a calf from the stall to leap into situations and ministries, charities and activities, relationships and conversations, invitations and forgiveness.

In the new year as we hear what God did in the early church, we will be asking the same thing of our church and its families. What is the next leap that God will inspire in our church and its families as we BRING others into right relationships with God? How is God BUILDing you and your children into those who leap? What are the messy and unpredictable places you will land as your leaps of faith BUMP into a lost and distracted world? You are God's promise for those already in your life as well as for the stranger. You have the faith to leap!






