- A faith guide should be a believer who is growing and desiring to know God more.
- One who has a God-given burden for teens.
- One who has a solid, Biblical, God-centered worldview.
- One who is not afraid of or inhibited from sharing that worldview with teens.
- One who regularly attends MLC services
- One who is approachable, personable, and loving to those who come to them.
- One who is available for some student ministry activities; to chaperone, drive, and serve.
- One who is willing to go through a background check.
- One who is willing to commit to attending student ministry meetings and available and willing to teach/ lead occasionally. (with direction & guidance from the Pastors)
- One who is willing to work with the Pastors in order to accomplish the mission and vision of the student ministry. (To help more teens fall more in love with Christ.)
- One who will follow the direction of the Pastors and bring any questions or concerns to them first. And follow the Biblical example for resolving disagreements!
